News from the State Initiative

Save The Date: Data Days Niedersachsen

For the first time, the "Data Days Niedersachsen" by FDM-NDS will take place in November! On November 13, the State Initiative invites members, NFDI participants, and researchers to a networking meeting. The event will be held in Hanover. On November 14, a digital training program on research data management (RDM) will be offered for researchers and interested parties.

You can apply for the FAIR Data and Software Award Lower Saxony 2024, which is being announced for the first time by FDM-NDS, until August 4, 2024. Under the patronage of Prof. Dr. York Sure-Vetter (Director of NFDI e.V.), datasets and software publications that best adhere to the FAIR principles are being sought in Lower Saxony. A prize of €3000 is up for grabs!

Number of Data Stewards in Pillar 2 is Growing!

The number of Data Stewards, who serve as RDM contact persons at the respective Pillar 2 universities, is growing (only 3 are still missing). They regularly exchange ideas in various formats: a weekly exchange meeting called "Weekly" has been held for a few weeks to discuss current needs, and the first "Data Steward Stammtisch" took place on June 18, 2024. Workshops on Electronic Lab Notebooks

In August, we are organizing two online workshops on electronic lab notebooks (ELNs). On August 6, 2024, we will introduce the ELN Chemotion ELN, which is of interest for chemistry and chemistry-related research. Two weeks later, on August 20, 2024, we will present the ELN eLabFTW. As a generic ELN, it can be used in many different research areas. Information about the two workshops can be found under the Events section, both workshop will be held in german.

Did you know?

The State Initiative is divided into three pillars. The goal of Pillar 1 is to establish a central service and advisory center for Lower Saxony for all questions related to research data management. Support services for all universities in Lower Saxony are to be provided centrally. This includes networking, coordination, creating and collecting materials, and advising on general questions about research data management (RDM) as well as subject-specific and special questions, such as legal aspects of RDM.
