At the beginning of August, Doreen Rocholl started her work in Work Package 5 (advising on questions regarding the legal framework in RDM). This means that the Pillar 1 team of FDM-NDS is now complete, and we are very much looking forward to future collaboration.

1. Einstein Your Data – Data Literacy for Students
